Facts About Donation

- ◆ People of all ages and medical histories should consider themselves potential donors. Your medical condition at the time of death will determine what organ and tissues can be donated.
- ◆ An open-casket funeral is possible. Throughout the entire donation process, the body is treated with care and respect. Funeral arrangements can continue as planned following donation.
- ◆ There is no cost to the donor's family or estate for donation. The donor family pays only for medical expenses before death and for funeral expenses unrelated to donation.
- ◆ You may be able to save a life while you are still living as a kidney or partial liver donor.

How You Can Help

- ◆ Register at LiveOnNebraska.org. Commit now to giving life to others. It is also a gift to your family to know your decision to help others.
- ◆ Consider being a living donor. This is not included in your deceased donor registration.
- ◆ Share your life-affirming decision to register with family, friends coworkers and community members. Ask them to consider doing the same.
